Epistle Reading: Heb. 4:14-5,6 Gospel Reading: Mk. 8:34-38; 9,1

Liturgical Message

The **Third Sunday of Great Lent** is dedicated to the **Veneration of the Holy Cross**, reminding us that the path to Christ's Resurrection goes through the Cross. At this midpoint of the Fast, the Church places the Cross before us as a source of strength and encouragement. Just as a traveler finds rest under the shade of a tree, we find spiritual renewal in the Cross, remembering Christ's sacrifice and the call to take up our cross daily.

Christ tells us, "Whoever desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me" (Mark 8:34). The Cross symbolizes not just suffering but victory over sin and death. Through fasting, prayer, and repentance, we carry our own crosses, dying to selfishness and growing in love for God and others. The Holy Cross teaches us that true joy comes through self-sacrifice and trust in God's will.

As we continue our Lenten journey, the Cross reminds us of the promise of the Resurrection. The struggles we endure now are preparing us for the joy of Pascha. Let us embrace the Fast with faith, drawing strength from the Cross, knowing that Christ has already conquered sin and death through it. "Through the Cross, joy has come into all the world!"
