Liturgical Message

On Palm Sunday, we remember the joyful entrance of our Lord Jesus Christ into Jerusalem when the people greeted Him with palm branches and shouts of "Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!" This moment is full of beauty and hope—Christ, the King of Glory, comes to His people, not with power and might but with humility, riding on a donkey. It is a powerful reminder that God's ways are not the ways of the world. True greatness is found in humility and love.

As we wave our palms and sing Hosanna in our churches, we are invited to welcome Christ into our hearts just as the people of Jerusalem welcomed Him into their city. But we must also recognize that Palm Sunday leads us into Holy Week—the path of Christ's suffering, death, and ultimately His Resurrection. The crowd's cheers will soon turn to shouts of "Crucify Him!" This shows us how easily we can turn away from God when our hearts are not steady and faithful.

Let us use this holy day to renew our commitment to follow Christ in moments of joy and through every part of the journey—even the difficult ones. Let us walk with Him this week with prayer, humility, and love, knowing His path leads to eternal life. Palm Sunday is not only a celebration—it is a calling to trust, follow, and prepare our hearts for the glory of Pascha.
